## Workshops

(These are all currently free of charge)



**Ask a Christian** sessions are a chance for children to simply ask questions about God, Christianity or things they have been learning about in RE lessons. These sessions can be a great way to start or end a particular RE topic for any year group. Timings, content and amount of children in one session are flexible to fit in with the school.



**Transit** is a workshop that aims to prepare year 6 pupils to make a successful transition to secondary school. It lasts 2 hours and is planned and led by our team, including a PowerPoint presentation, class activities and opportunities for discussion.

## RE days & iwonder spaces



On an RE day, a SSW team member will deliver an action-packed, fast-moving day linked to a set RE topic. We provide all resources and teaching materials. SSW RE days meet the requirements for AT1 (learning about religion) and AT2 (learning from religion).

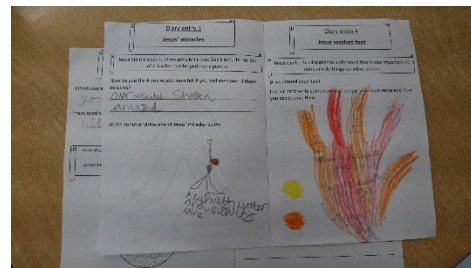
**We are offering a reduced selection of themes/year groups during the summer term.**

This term we will be offering **iwonder spaces** in a slightly different format. We will run the session in a classroom, with minimal set up, and it will last one hour. Each child will be given an '**iwonder bag**' to keep, containing items which will be the focus of a time of stillness and reflection. The **iwonder sessions** will be on the theme of '**Our Senses**' tying in with our summer online assemblies; they are aimed at Key Stage 2.
